**COURT ORDER GRANTING FINAL APPROVAL OF CLASS  
ACTION SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

Upon application of the Plaintiff Class and by Defendant, the Circuit Court grants final approval of the Class Action Settlement Agreement which is attached to this Order.

1. The case was filed on July 28, 2017.
2. This case involves the City of Overland’s imposition of a special deterrent fee (“SDF”) upon some defendants in the Overland Municipal Court.
3. There are approximately 344 class members who paid a SDF in the Overland Municipal Court from August 12, 2012, until September 10, 2021.
4. The Circuit Court certified the class on September 10, 2021.
5. On January 28, 2026, counsel for the Plaintiff Class and for Defendant announced to the Circuit Court that a settlement agreement had been reached.
6. On February 25, 2026, the Circuit Court granted preliminary approval of the Class Action Settlement Agreement (which is attached to this Order).

7. On this date, the Circuit Court has been informed that no class member has “opted out” of the Class Action Settlement Agreement nor objected to the Class Action Settlement Agreement.

8. On February 25, 2026, the Circuit Court preliminarily approved the Settlement Agreement for which Plaintiffs, with the consent of Defendant, now seek final approval.

9. The Settlement Agreement presented to the Circuit Court has the following salient features:

A. Each member of the class who completes a short application form will receive \$80.00.

B. Each class member has 6 months from final approval to send in his application for payment.

C. The named plaintiff Alec Brimmer will receive \$2500.

D. Class counsel will receive a fee of \$15,000.


E. After six months have passed after final approval no further applications will be accepted.

10. Notice of the Settlement Agreement and the final approval hearing were mailed to all class members, posted at Overland City Hall, and, mentioned on Overland’s website.

11. There have been no objectors nor opt outs from the Settlement Agreement.

12. The Circuit Court finds that the proposed Class Action Settlement Agreement is fair and beneficial to the Class.

Therefore, this Circuit Court grants final approval of the Class Action Settlement Agreement and allow the payments and all other actions and obligations to be immediately carried out.
